

Chapter 10 - MSDOS Print Queue

Users of Windows 95/98/NT/2000/ME and LAN (Local Area Network) Users:

This Print Queue section uses the DOS Print command and is therefore **operative** only for users running MSDOS (not Windows). Windows and LAN's have their own print spoolers. Instead of this Print Queue described here, use the Windows Print Manager or Network print spooler, not this part of Natural Log.

BACKGROUND PRINTING Many of the print functions of the Natural Log System perform "Background" printing using the DOS Print command. That is, the printout is done by the computer while you can still use the Natural Log system for other tasks. This is especially helpful when printing long lists and Logs.

USE OF PRINT QUEUE When you select **Print Queue** at the MAIN MENU, a list of the jobs will be printed to the screen, each with an identifying number. If the print queue is empty, hit [ESC] to exit the **Print Queue** function.

Job #	*** Print Queue Status ***
1	LOGS-1\11-01-91.OUT is currently being printed
2	LOGS-1\11-02-91.OUT is in Queue

If there are pending print jobs, you will see the PRINT QUEUE MENU. You may **Cancel**. This will ask you for the number of the job to cancel. Enter **A** to cancel all print jobs.
